Operation Hydrant is coordinating multiple non-recent child sexual abuse investigations around the country. Relevant investigations are those which involve either people of public prominence and/or abuse that has taken place in an institution. In most cases the victims are reporting abuse that took place when they were children.

The College of Policing has developed an <u>updated 2020 version of the original senior</u> <u>investigating officer (SIO) advice to support forces running such investigations</u>. This advice replaces previous versions of the document.

The <u>Hydrant Programme Group on Knowledge Hub</u> provides further restricted detail and a platform for practitioners to highlight investigative areas presenting specific challenges.
